



Make Chrome Default Browser SmartPhone

Android (eg Samsung) - Make Google Chrome the Default Browser

- If you don't already have it you may need to install Google Chrome from the Play Store.
- Next, open the Settings app, scroll until you see 'Apps' or 'Applications' and then tap on it.
- Now, tap on 'Default Apps' or 'Default Applications'
- Scroll until you see the setting labelled "Browser App" and then tap on it to choose your default browser.
- From the list of browsers, select 'Chrome'. If it is not listed you may not have the app installed. Go back to first step.
- You can close the settings.
- The next time you tap a link, it will open in Chrome.

Windows Phone - Make Google Chrome the Default Browser

- You may need to install Google Chrome from the Play Store if it isn't already installed.
- Open up System settings by pressing Windows key+I, and then click on 'Apps'
- From the pane on the left side, click 'Default Apps'
- Locate the Web Browser section, click on your current default browser, and then scroll through the list and select 'Google Chrome'. If it is not listed you may not have the app installed. Go back to first step.
- Under Web Browser, click the current default, and then click on Google Chrome from the list that appears.
- Close Settings and that's it. Chrome is now your default web browser.
