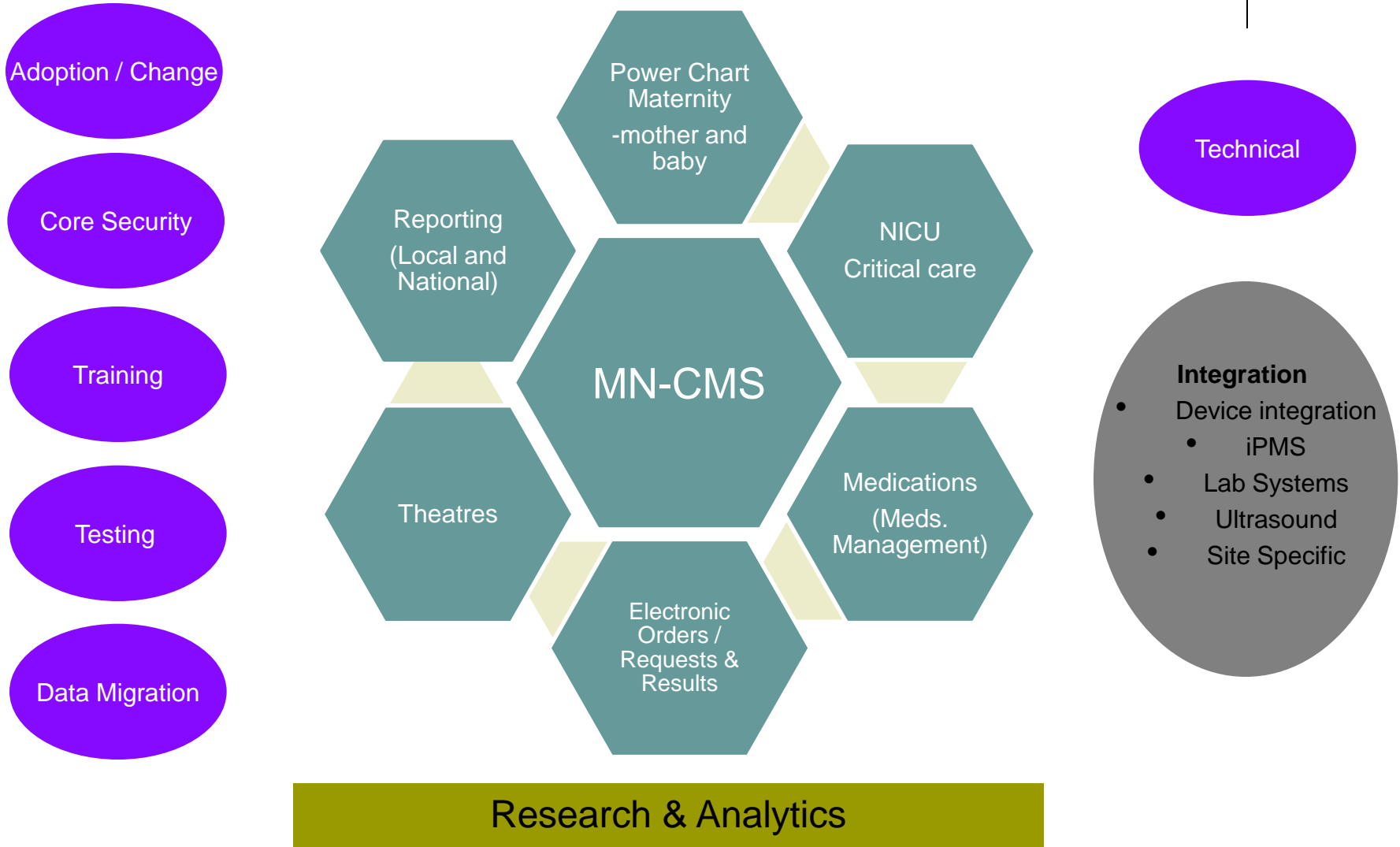

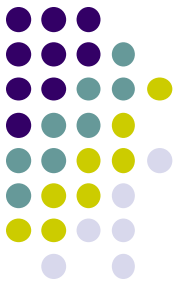
MN-CMS: A full EHR for Mothers and Babies



What is Future State Validation (FSV)

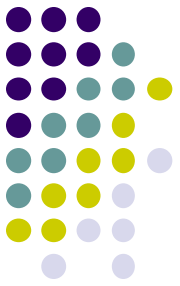


- Present System & Workflows as developed (National Project Team & Work Streams)

Objectives of the FSV:

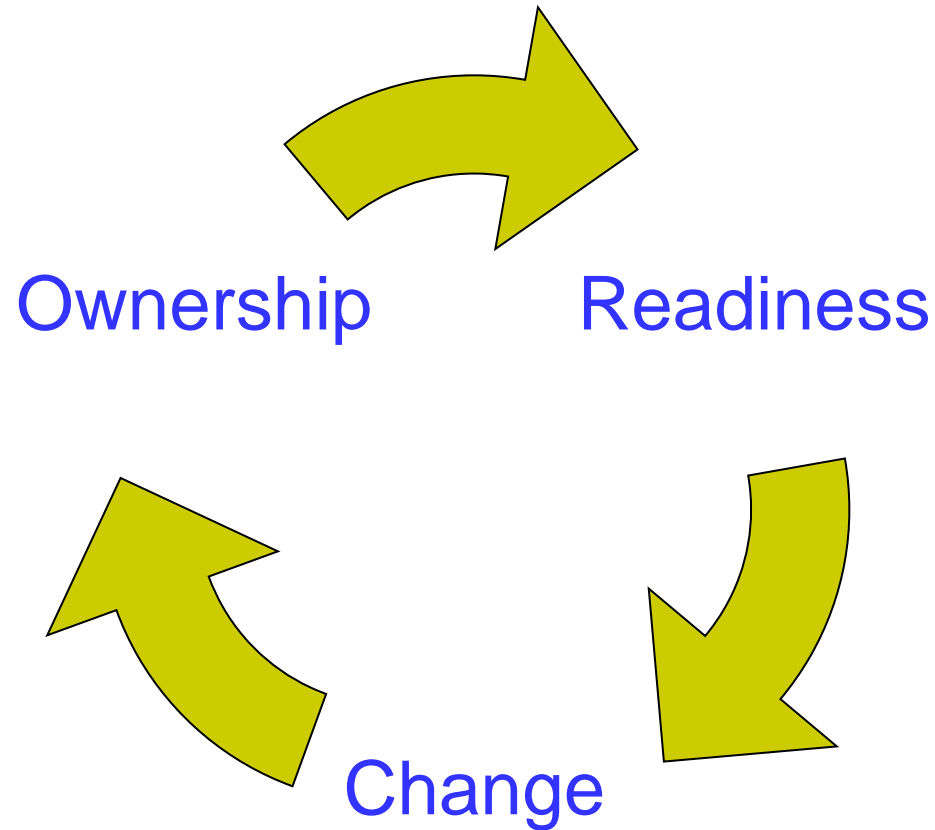
- See system as developed (To Date)

 - Demonstrating system locally

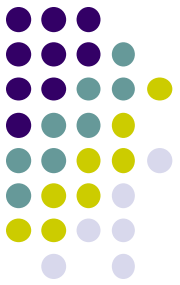

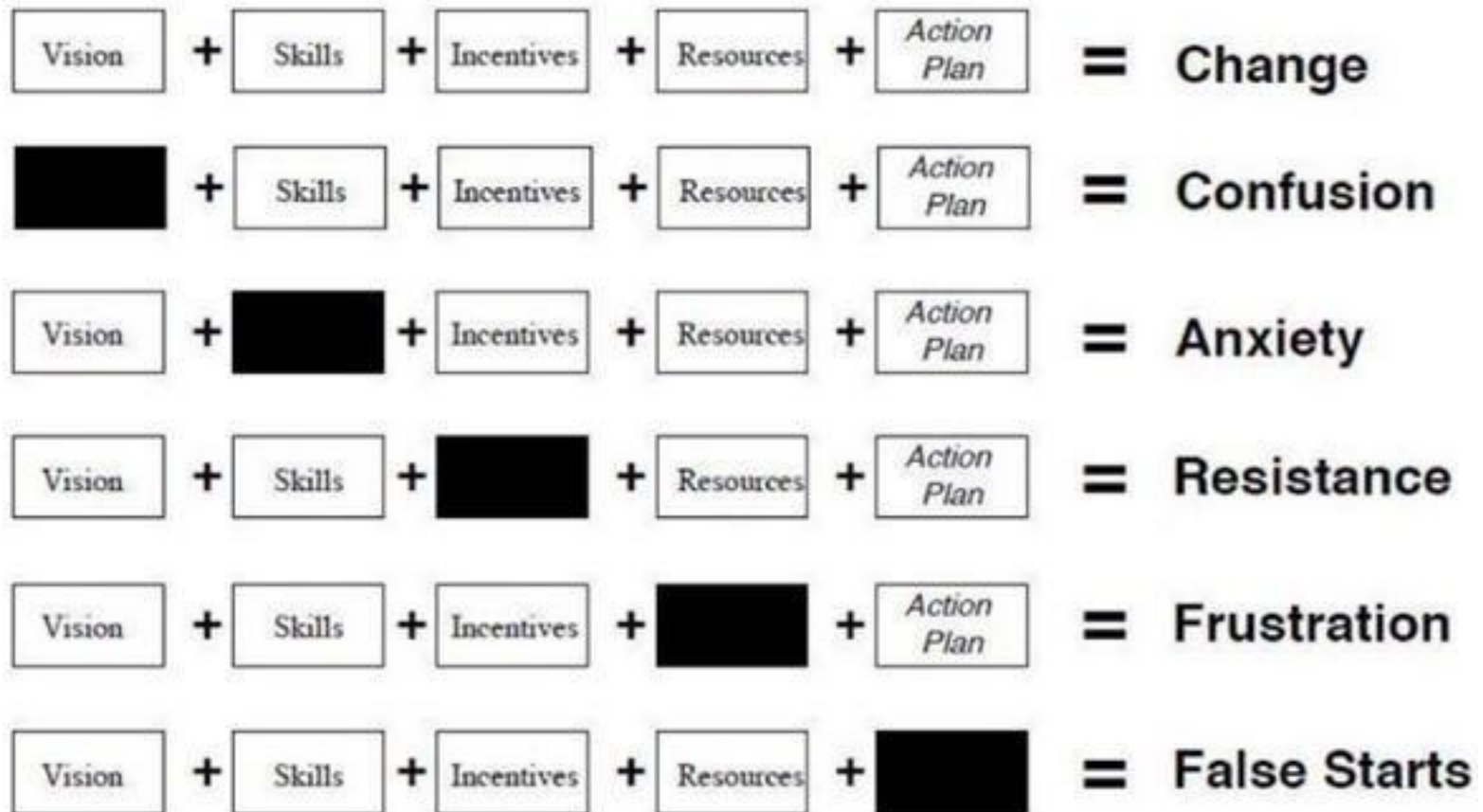
- Build Complete & Sign Off

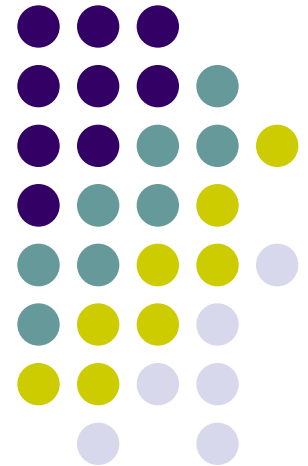

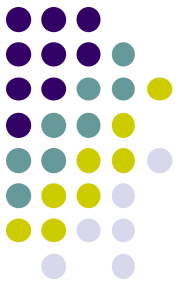
