- Current strategy is **10 years old** and constraining vision
- Need to evolve from eHealth to Digital Health – **Digital Services not eHealth Systems**
- Leverage Global **Digital Technology** Developments, **data** to inform decision making & learn from **experience** in our service & other countries
- **Patient Expectations** of the use of Digital have increased as have **demands for services**
- **EU obligations & Targets** - the EU Digital Decade and European Health Data Space Directive & **Government** Digital Strategy ‘Harnessing Digital’
- Learnings from the **Pandemic & Cyber-attack**
- Establishment of **RHAs**, a need to **enable integrated care** and emergence of **Health Information Bill** to clarify obligations to share
- Need for a vision to **align & secure commitment**

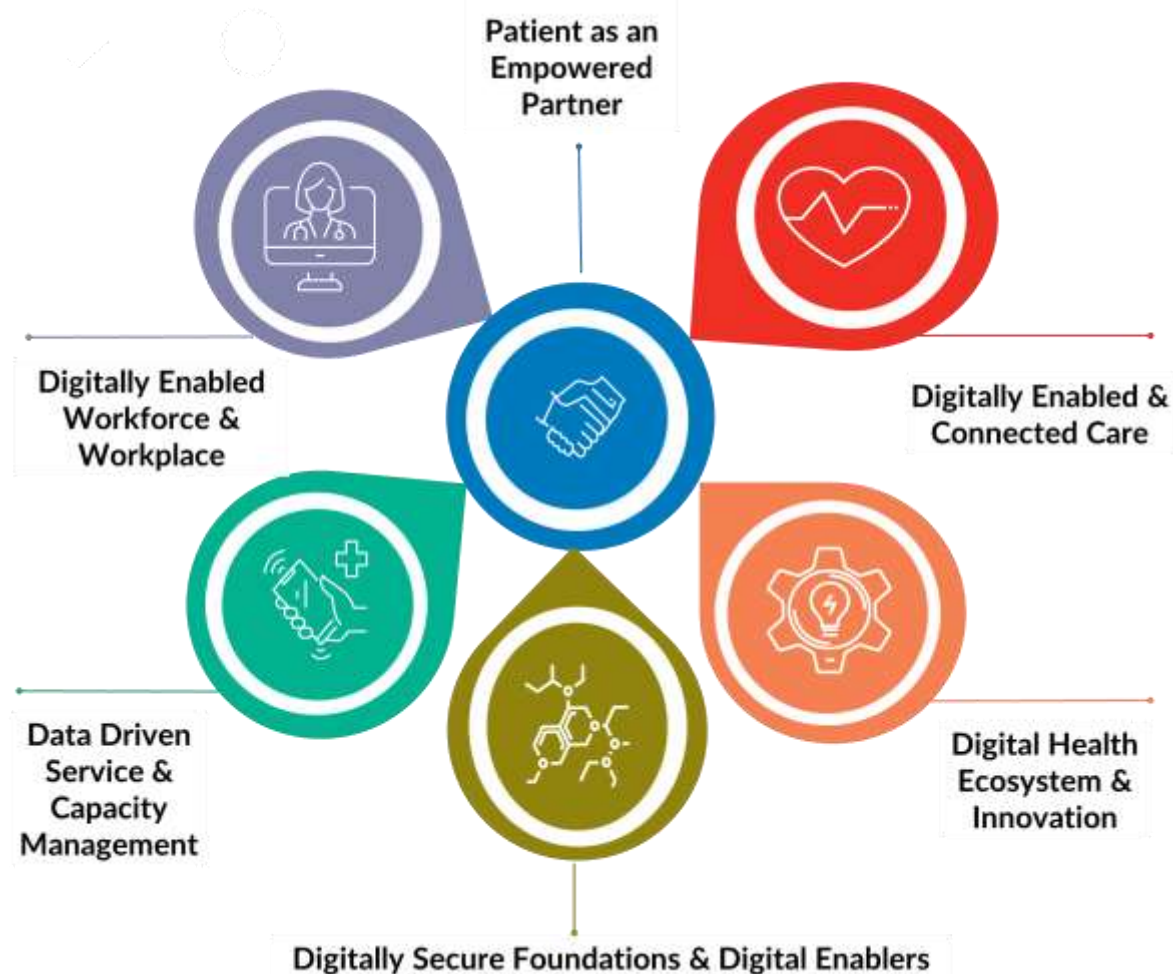


Our Vision

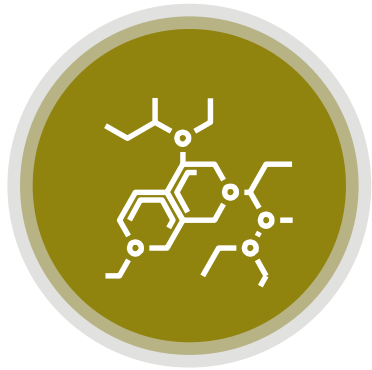
“Leveraging and developing our digital innovation ecosystem whilst harnessing new and emerging technologies to innovate how we deliver care.”

Next Steps



- Seek Government approval of policy direction
- Work with Government to secure increased investment through the National Development Plan (NDP) to enhance the provision of digital health.
- Ensure that the 6 principles guide the development of rolling multi-year action plans for digital health
- Enact the Health Information Bill, to transform the health information system into one that is fit for purpose and best serves important stakeholders.
- Development interoperability standards, governance and infrastructure arrangements for standardisation to enable seamless information flow across healthcare settings
- Use existing partnerships, new arrangements and ways of delivery to propel the delivery of digital services across the health and social care system.
