It is not recommended to share Headsets due to Infection Control




Frivacy and sorting up your room

Privacy and confidentially is important just like in a face to face appointment



Things to consider:

- a private, well-lit area where the healthcare professional will not be disturbed during a consultation
- ensure that visual and audio information in the room background is limited, does not display personal material such as photographs / books /posters and does not breach data governance guidelines
- Consider the use of headphones, they can emphasise that you are taking confidentiality seriously
- It is important that settings used by healthcare professional are distraction-free and quiet for the duration of the video call. For example, switching off any other apps/notifications and avoidance of interruptions by others in the clinical environments



HE Room Checklist

Item	Description
Electrical sockets and network points	 Minimum recommendation: 4 Electrical sockets for computer, monitor etc. 2 Network points for computer
Phone	Ensure access to a phone as a back-up if the video call fails.
Furniture	A desk and two chairs in the room (caller, representative). Chair for the caller should be positioned in front of the video screen but not too close.
Lighting	Diffused lighting is better for video consultations than harsh overhead lighting. Neutral White Black out blind is required to prevent sunlight obscuring the screen and also for privacy purposes.
Signs	Sign on consultation room door "Room in use: do not enter"
Clinical supplies	Cleaning wipes Alcohol gel



H Option 1 One to One Online Consultations


- > Best suited for one to one online consultations

H Option 2 Small group consultations/ Using multiple systems


- ➤ Best suited for small group online consultations where you need to view several callers at once
- ➤ Also suited for viewing the caller and another system e.g. patient records, x-ray/bloods or screen sharing




Solution 3Large Group Consultations


- ➤ Best suited for large group consultations where you need to view several callers at once. Local assistance will be needed for mounting monitor to wall
- ➤ Suitable for larger room approx 6m x 6m or larger. If smaller room consider 31.5" Wide Screen monitor from Option 2





















Option 4Interactive Consultations

- ➤ Best suited for clinicians providing interactive classes to patients e.g. showing exercises
- ➤ Wide angled camera gives a wide view of room. This allows the clinician to demonstrate full body movements to the service user. It may also be beneficial to choose a larger screen if necessary

Benefits:


Can be tailored to meet service users needs Mobile/ Flexible Increase communication
