MN-CMS is a Finalist in the 2023 Tech Excellence Awards

We are delighted to announce that the **MN-CMS Antenatal Visit Medication Inbound Messaging Project** has been shortlisted for a Tech Excellence Award. MN-CMS has optimised its capabilities to accept and file medication and vaccine information provided by the GP as part of the electronic ANV Shared Care messaging via Healthlink. To enhance patient care and medication safety MN-CMS advanced from a baseline of non-standardised medication information in the patient record from multiple GP systems to a clear, relevant and timely medication and vaccination history automatically filed in the EHR thereby improving medication safety at transitions of care.

This project was a pathfinder, standardising medication-related information between GP systems and the EHR, a building-block of Irish Summary Care Record development, as envisaged by 'Sláintecare'. It was a multi-disciplinary project led by a Senior Informatics Pharmacist and Senior Project Manager and will be the basis upon which further MN-CMS medication optimisation will be developed.

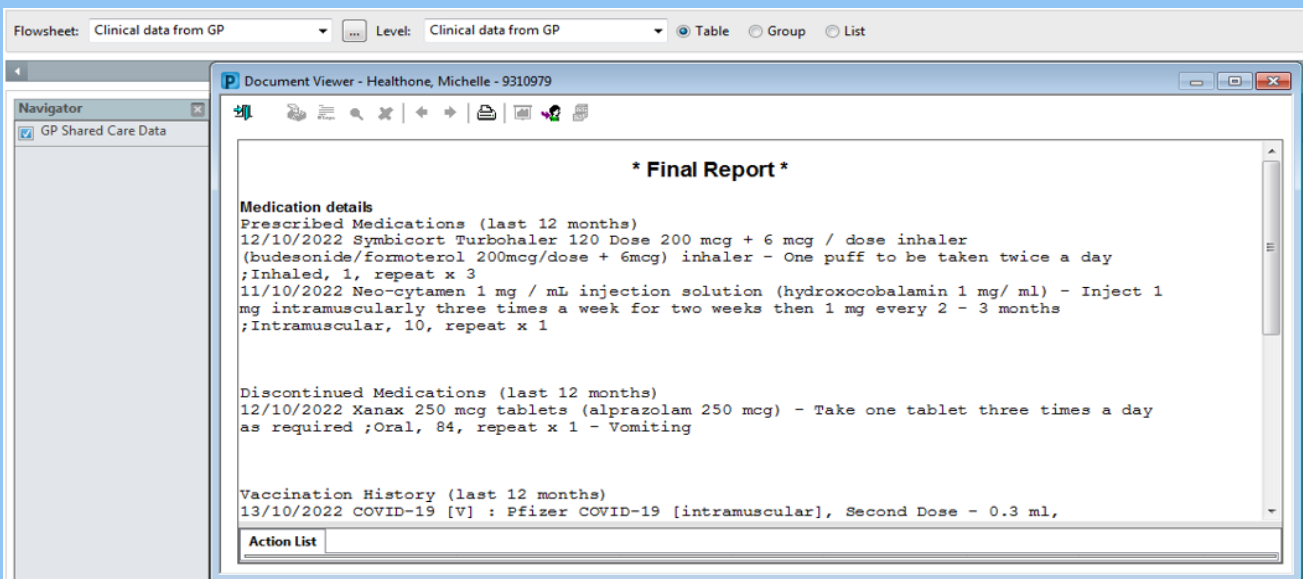


Image 2— Example of medication details as it appears in the patient’s EHR after solution deployment.
