


### **HSE Cyber-Attack One Year On**

### COVID-19 Vaccination Management System (COVAX)

IT Project of the Year

at the Tech Excellence Awards 25 May 2022

The COVID-19 Vaccination Management System (Covax) was awarded Public Sector IT Project of the Year at the Tech Excellence Awards on 25th May 2022. This was a significant achievement in a category that included projects from An Garda Siochana, Failte Ireland and eHealth RPA Delivery team. A submission focussing on Covax Kiosk Mode was also shortlisted in the Digital Innovation category.

The objective of the Vaccination programme is to facilitate the scheduling and recording of Covid vaccinations for the population of Ireland as quickly and efficiently as possible and this could not have been done without a robust ICT System and technology infrastructure enabling and supporting the overall programme.

The offices in Southgate, Drogheda, represent a significant increase in eHealths' presence in the Northeast of the country and will have a catchment area which will include North County Dublin, the Western parts of Meath, as well as Louth and Monaghan.

Overall, there are approximately one hundred and twenty workstations, set out as open plan and one and two-person offices, along with large meeting rooms and break out rooms.

On October 24th, eHealth held its first away day since before the Coronavirus Pandemic. A further goal of the day was to introduce new staff and reconnect the wider teams and functions. The event was opened with an address from the Acting Chief Executive Officer of the HSE Stephen Mulvany

The eHealth Leadership Programme final day was held on 30th November, 2022 in the Richmond Education Centre in Smithfield, Dublin. We featured all of the participants in our December issue - 17 participants in total.

The 8 day Leadership programme commenced on 17th May and concluded on 30th November 2022.

This eight-day programme aims to advance the effectiveness of seasoned managers

by challenging them with new insights, high energy learning exercises using best practices and tools as well as Action Learning opportunities.

On the final day of the programme, the participants delivered a 'pitch' to eHealth's Senior Management Team on an initiative that enhances services to the organisation. 17 participants took part in the programme, with 13 pitches presented on the final day.
